Mission and Ministry in the Age of Migration

At a time when the growing number of people who want, or need, to move do so in increasingly harsh, dehumanizing, and tragic conditions, and in a climate of heightened social division and polarisation, where some humanitarians, immigration advocates and activists, as well as faith-based workers and volunteers are being marginalized, arrested, or prosecuted, where and how might Christians incarnate the gospel?

At this conversation Gemma Tulud Cruz will reflect with us how mission and ministry might look like for Christians and those in the United States, in general, and Catholics, in particular, in the context of the current global and national social climate as far as (im)migration is concerned.



Gemma Tulud Cruz, a Filipina-Australian theologian teaching at the Australian Catholic University in Melbourne, has published and given lectures and presentations on migration in various parts of the world. She is the current recipient of Boston College School of Theology and Ministry's International Fellowship Initiative.
